This comic is a parody by Anton Kannemeyer and Conrad Bates. This edition is inscribed. It is comic number five in the series. This edition was printed in 1996.

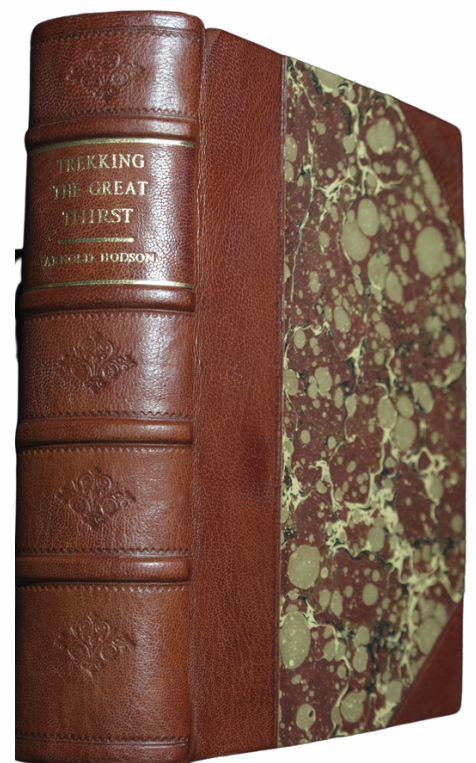

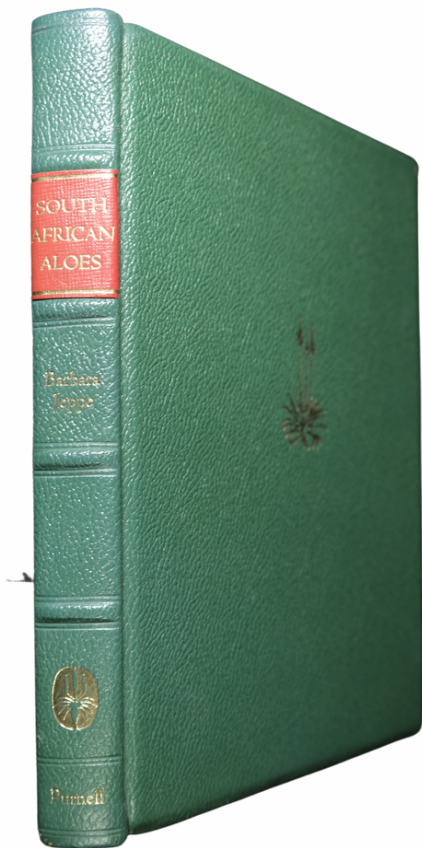
TREKKING THE GREAT THIRST

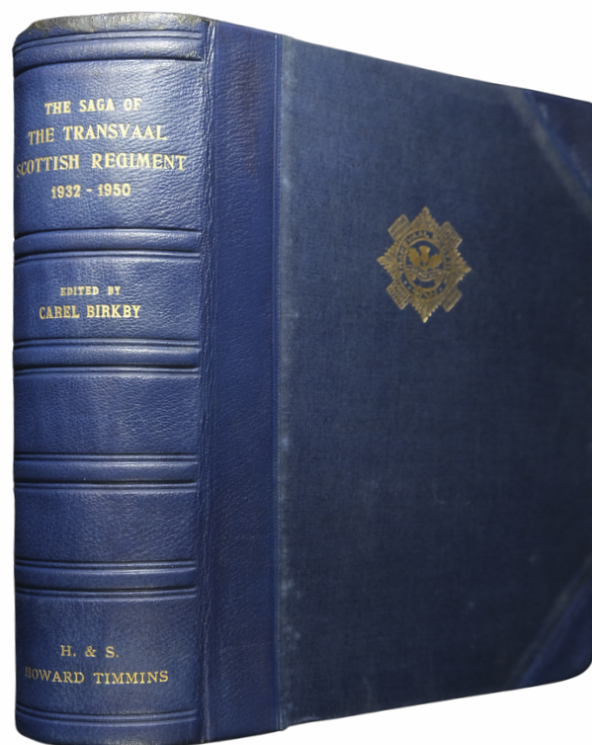

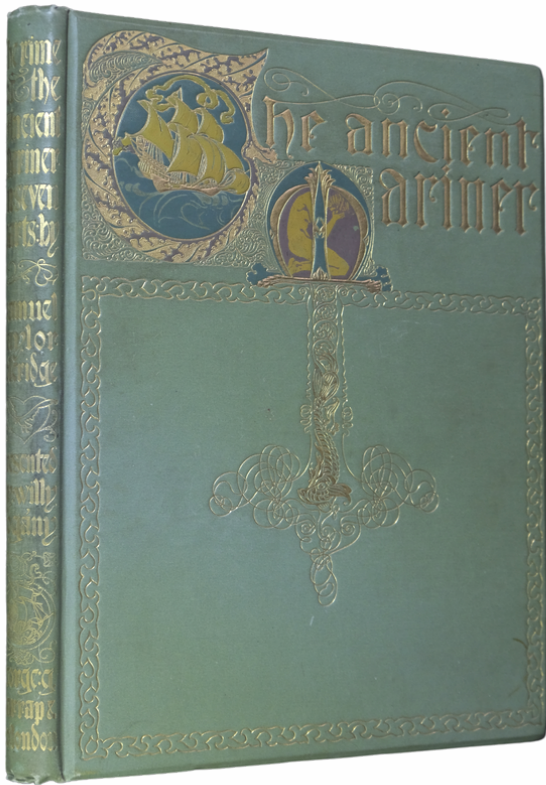
JUMPERS DEEP GOLD MINE
